Sub: Additional allotment of rice under the Emergency Feeding Programme for
the year 2002-03.

Sir,

In this Department's letter No.10250/WCD., dtd.17.04.2002 instructions have been issued to the Collectors to purchase 5 kgs of Rice at BPL rates from ^{the} F.C.I. and the balance 1 kg of rice from the FCI at APL rates or from ^{the} open market from wherever better quality of rice at lesser rate is available. Thus, 6 kgs of rice are being supplied as the monthly ration in the form of cooked food to each beneficiary under the Emergency Feeding Programme (EFP).

2. This arrangement had been made to keep the monthly scale of ration of each EFP beneficiary at 6 kgs even though Government of India were allocating rice @ of 5 kgs per head per month. The Government of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, have now made an additional allocation of 6185 MTs of BPL rice in favour of the State Govt. which can accommodate the additional 1 kg of rice per head per month to be provided to the EFP beneficiaries. The Food Supplies and Consumer Welfare Department have accordingly allotted an additional 200 MTs of rice per month for the Emergency Feeding Programme (2,00,000 beneficiaries x 1 kg.).

3. Kindly refer to this Deptt.'s earlier letter No.10250/dtd.17.04.2002 wherein the District-wise allocation of BPL rice under EFP was communicated to the district @ 5 kgs per head per month for the 2,00,000 beneficiaries covered under the Programme. In this connection, this Deptt.'s letter No.11468/WCD dtd.09.05.2002 addressed to the SRM, FCI, Bhubaneswar with copy marked to the Collectors in Memo No.11469/dtd.09.05.2002 may also kindly be referred to .

4. The further allocation of 200 MTs to cover the additional 1 kg of rice per head per month is divided among the districts on the basis of the targeted number of beneficiaries in the following manner:

You are therefore requested to purchase the entire requirement of 6 kgs of rice per beneficiary per month under the Emergency Feeding Programme at BPL rates from the FCI during the entire year, 2002-2003. These instructions supersede the earlier instructions issued by the Department to purchase 1 kg of rice per beneficiary per month at APL rates issued in this Deptt's. letter No.10250/dtd.17.04.2002. Funds are available in all the Districts from the last year's allotment and hence there should be no delay in purchase of the foodgrains.
