1. Background & Justification

Human trafficking is a multi-dimensional problem encompassing a whole range of economic, social and cultural issues which are varied and complex. Most of the victims are lured with promises of jobs, better career prospects and marriage.

Despite rapid urbanization, availability of livelihood and improving literacy rate among the inhabitants, migration of women & girl children outside the State in pursuit of work leading to financial and sexual exploitation has become a matter of concern for the State. In order to initiate remedial action, the State Government plans to take up a mapping study in the matter.

2. Study Objectives

- Identification of the areas with high rate of trafficking of women & girls in the State.
- Mapping of occurrence of trafficking across the study area with village as a unit.
- Identification of the reasons / causes of trafficking from districts
- Identification of the factors / sources / agencies / linkages responsible for trafficking
- Matching with the information available on trafficking in different quarters
- Consult & study the rescued / rehabilitated victims to identify various angles of trafficking (Case Study)
- Study the post-rehabilitation socio-economic / health status of the victims of trafficking for proper planning on rehabilitation measures
- Recommend ways and means to check the menace.

3. Scope of the Assignment

- Study in the Districts in general and in the Blocks having trafficking problem in particular.
- Study of the available Police, Civil Administration records & reports on studies by various groups, press releases and indicate factual coherence.
- Contacting key persons, eminent villagers, PRI members, Civil Societies, NGOs & grass-root level institutions for extensive study in the field in affected Gram Panchayats and formation of inferences.
- To come out with clear-cut recommendations, based on statistically representative (size & mix) sample study. It is important that the agency indicate the sample size such that the study is representative of the issue of trafficking in the entire State.
- Preparation of text of the Study with reference to the observation & studies.

4. Timeline and Deliverable

- The entire work must be completed within a period *not exceeding Six months (24 Weeks)*.
- The 1st draft report should be submitted to the Department by the 18thWeek for review and remarks
- The final report should incorporate the changes suggested by the department which may include methodology and approach, if required
- Report would be finalized after sharing with the Department on the issues identified and studied in the field.

5. Suitability to carry out the Study

- Capability of conducting study through a team of field surveyors / data collectors or in collaboration with local NGOs / individuals
- Desk research through experienced research persons / team
- Interview through skilled experienced researchers / investigators
- Experience in any kind of study / research in the District
- Previous experience in study on trafficking related issues
- Availability of research / investigation manpower
- Plan of action to conduct the study in the District
- Study /research publications, if so, last three.
