

RESOLUTION

No. HW-I(A)-25/2004. 753E /W&CD, Dt. 20.3.04

Sub:- Enhancement of the rates of stipend to disabled children in the residential schools - amendment of the rules governing grant-in-aid to the Institutions imparting education to the handicapped children, 1985.

In order to ensure free education to the children with disabilities, State Government are sanctioning financial assistance for payment of stipend to these children in the residential schools being run by the Voluntary Organisations recognised by State Government in W & C.D. Department in pursuance of the rule 5 of the Rules Governing Grant-in-aid to the Institutions imparting education to Handicapped Children, 1985.

Government have, for quite some time, been contemplating upward revision in the rates of stipend for the children with disabilities studying in Special Schools being run through recognised Voluntary Organisations in the State, in view of the rising cost of living.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Rule-9(4) of the Rules Governing Grant-in-aid to the Institutions imparting Education to Handicapped Children, 1985 and in supersession of Notification No. 7785 dt. 1.7.98 issued by W & C.D. Department, Government, after careful consideration, have been pleased to enhance the existing rate of stipend @ Rs. 300/- P.M. per beneficiary to Rs. 500/- P.M. per beneficiary payable to residential Schools run by the Voluntary Organisations with financial support from W & C.D. Department as follows:

<u>Stipend Component</u>	<u>Revised rate per month per beneficiary</u>
1. Food	Rs. 350/-
2. Bedding and Clothing	Rs. 60/-
3. Educational expenses	Rs. 50/-
4. Contingencies	Rs. 10/-
5. Medical expenses	Rs. 10/-
6. Rent, maintenance & Building	Rs. 20/-
	<u>Rs. 500/-</u>

The enhanced rate will be effective from 01.04.2004.

The scale of expenditure under different items indicated above, can be interchanged subject to prior written permission of the Collector. However during such interchange, the provision on food shall not be reduced under any circumstances.
