RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL PROGRAMME FOR REHABILITATION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (NPRPD).

In order to enhance facilities and services at the grass root level, the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment have launched a programme namely "National Programme for Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities" (NPRPD) under which comprehensive rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities can be provided through a four tier structure right from Gram Panchayat level to the State level, viz;-G.P., Block, District and State for ensuring a meaningful integration of the persons with disabilities with self-esteem in the society.

As a step towards rehabilitation of persons with disabilities, the State Govt. propose to set up infrastructure with a focus on provision of services of identification, early detection and intervention, through a community based approach and referral services at the District and State level.

Keeping the above objective in view, State Government, after careful consideration, have decided to implement the above Programme according to the following guidelines:

- a) The G.P. level services, i.e., survey and identification of the disabled, creation of awareness regarding opportunities to be provided to them will be taken up by the Community Based Rehabilitation Workers (CBRWs).
- b) Rehabilitation services at the Block level will be taken up by the Multipurpose Rehabilitation Workers (MRWs) who will be responsible for providing services to persons with disabilities in coordination with other Departments.
- c) At the District level there shall be one District Level Referral Resource Centre to provide services in all types of specialities. The Centre will maintain a liaison with other Institutions and coordinate the activities of Govt. as well as Non Govt. Organizations working for the welfare of disabled persons.
- d) Training to CBRWs and MRWs will be conducted through the District Centres.
- e) At the Apex Level, there shall be a State Institute of Disability Rehabilitation (SIDR) to supervise and look after the overall functioning of the Centres at the District level, which in turn would monitor the activities from the G.P. level to the Block level.
- f) The existing DRC at Bhubaneswar will be upgraded to a State Institute of Disability Rehabilitation (SIDR) and shall function as the Nodal Agency for implementation of the Scheme. The DRC staff shall be deployed in the District Centres in accordance with the Govt. of India guidelines.

- g) To monitor and coordinate the above National Programme for Rehabilitation of Persons Disabilities throughout the State, there shall be a State Level Advisory Committee. The State Executive Committee for Persons with Disabilities established under the PWD Act shall function as the State Level Advisory Committee to monitor implementation of the programme.
- h) Training of Rehabilitation Workers at all levels will be taken up by the District Authorities as per the syllabus prescribed by the RCI in collaboration with the existing Training Centres operating in the State.
- i) The scheme will be implemented initially in Khurda, Sambalpur and Kalahandi District.

Detailed instructions on implementation of the Scheme will be issued by the Women and Child Development Department from time to time.




