

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 34(1) of the Juvenile Justice [Care & Protection of Children] Act, 2000, the following child-care institutions are certified as children's Homes for the reception of child in need of care & protection during the pendency of any enquiry and subsequently for their care, treatment, education, training, development and rehabilitation until further orders.

BACKGROUND NOTE ON IMPLEMENTATION OF JUVENILE JUSTICE (CARE & PROTECTION OF CHILDREN) ACT, 2000

1. Government of India enacted Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act 2000
2. Govt. of Orissa have drafted and notified the rules during the year, 2002.
3. As per Section-4 of the J.J. (Care & Protection of Children) Act 2000 and rule-3 of the said rule, 28 numbers of Juvenile Justice Boards have been constituted vide this department Notification No. 1908/dt. 12.9.03 and No. 12487/ dt. 28.6.04. The tenure of the J.J. B. is three years and the appointment of the Members is co-terminous with the tenure of the Board. But because of the some techno-legal problem, J.J.Bs in many of the Districts, could not function properly. However, action has already been taken for reconstitution of the Board.
4. For maintenance of the Juveniles in Conflict with law, Observation Homes have been established. Three observation Homes are being run by state Govt. and 1 observation Homes is being run by the N.G.O under section -9 of the JJ Act, 2000.
5. As per Rule-29 of the J.J. (C & P of Children) Act, 2000 CWCs are to be constituted by the State Govt. As per rule -24 of the J.J. (C & P of children) Rules, 2002, W&CD Deptt. has notified the constitution of the Child Welfare Committee in all the 30 Districts vide this Department Notification No. 19039/dt. 11.9.03 and No. 8629/ dt. 23.3.05.
6. There are 12 Children's Homes (list annexed) in operation, for the children in need of care & protection (Copy enclosed). The CWC are supposed to sit in the premises of the Children's Homes. Since the CWC have started demanding for creation of children's Homes, action has already been initiated for declaration of more numbers of Children's Homes.

Since the J.J. (C & P of Children) Act 2000 is not very old, the members of the CWC find it difficult to handle the cases as per the provisions of the Act & Rule. To sensitize the members of the CWC, Govt. have already organised training programmes and there is further scope for improvement by way of providing impetus and inputs to the members of the C.W.C. .

- (a) The training programme of all CWC members was organized during the year 2004 by the Department at Rajiv Bhawan in Collaboration with CRY.
- (b) The Training programme of CWC members and DSWO was recently organized in Collaboration with OLS during the month of Feb'06.
- (c) Trainings have been also organised for police officers / NGOs for sensitization on their role, responsibilities according to JJ Act, 2000. For this purpose, Mahila & Sishu Desks in 150 (One hundred fifty) police stations have been constituted and they are undergoing training.

Even though, Juvenile justice system is on operation for quite some time long, the general public are not aware about constitution and function of J.J. B. & CWC. Awareness Campaign and publicity drive has to be undertaken for popularizing the concept of juvenile justice system.

In pursuance of Section 61 of the Juvenile Justice (C& P of Children) Act 2000, the State Govt. have created a fund named Juvenile Justice fund for welfare of juveniles, vide notification no. -23318/29.11.2005.

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 62 (2) of the Juvenile [C &P of Children] Act, 2000 read with Rule-57(2) of the Juvenile Justice (C & P of Children) Orissa Rules, 2002, the State Govt. have constituted the State Advisory Board for Juvenile Justice Services. The Board shall discuss on welfare of Juveniles & Children from time to time.
