But it is often seen that the management of the Orphanages are not taking required interest for improvement of standard of education. ~~As~~ ^{It} appears from the Matriculation result, the performance of orphanage inmates is not satisfactory. In order to provide a better standard of life, the Govt. has enhanced the scale of GIA from Rs.300/- to Rs.500/- per inmate per month which also includes the enhancement under educational component. You are, therefore, requested to engage Tutor / Tutors as the case may be from this educational year (2005-06) so as to improve the educational standard of the inmates. Any experienced in-service Science / Mathematics / English Teacher of the nearby High School having some social commitment may be entrusted with the job. Any retired Headmaster/may also be requested to come forward for the social obligation. The management are free to decide the amount of remuneration for those Tutor/Tutors ~~depending upon their resource position~~ ^{out of the education Cor}
