
- 1) for mild & moderate children - Rs. 2.00
- 2) for Severely malnourished children - Rs. 2.70
- 3) for Pregnant & Lactating Mother - Rs. 2.30

In view of this a Committee has been formed consisting of PC-cum-Deputy Secretary, Dy. Secy. (NTN), Dr. Gayatri Singh UNICEF, representative of CARE, WFP, FNB, Director of Health Services, DSWO (HQ) for examining the whole issue and give suggestion basing on which ration component will be revised taking Govt. of India revised cost norm and calorie & protein norm in to consideration.

It has also been decided to hold a meeting on dt. 31.05.2006 at 3PM in the red building conference hall of the Deptt.

It is therefore requested to make it convenient to attend the meeting.




