Sub: Revision of ration size under Supplementary Nutrition Programme.

Sir,

I am directed to say that consequent upon the Government decision to switch over to rice instead of wheat under the Supplementary Nutrition Programme, it has become imperative to revise the volume of ration in order to meet the calories and protein standard in conformity with the prescribed nutritional norms under ICDS.

Government after careful consideration have been pleased to revise the volume of ration under the Supplementary Nutrition Programme as below:

Sl. No.	Category	Ration size	
		Rice	Dal
1.	Mild and moderate children (6months -6years)	80gm	15 gm
2.	Severely malnourished children	160gm	30 gm
3.	Pregnant & lactating mothers.	200gm	35 gm

Above quantity will be applicable for all take-home ration cases. For spot feeding, expenditure other than cereal / pulse will continue to be governed by the instruction communicated vide this Deptt. Letter No.165/SWCD., dt.13.5.05 (Copy enclosed) or as modified from time to time.

This order will take immediate effect.

The current allocation for wheat based Supplementary Nutrition Programme per beneficiary per day for a single dose of ration is as follows:

(i) Wheat	..	80 gm. Re.0.35 P
(ii) Dal	..	14 gm. Re.0.33 P
(iii) Jaggery	..	20 gm. Re.0.22 P
(iv) If salt	..	Re.0.02 P
(v) TC	..	Re.0.10 P
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Total	..	Re.1.02 P


After supply of jaggery has been dispensed with, doubts have been raised about the nature of the cooked SNP. Similarly, difficulties have been experienced regarding palatability of the cooked SNP of wheat and dal only. In some places, families are contributing sugar and oil and different dishes are being prepared.

It is hereby clarified that Re.0.24 P, which had earlier been earmarked towards the cost of jaggery and If salt can now be utilized for purchase of necessary amount of oil, condiments, salt and fuel, as the case may be. The flexibility has been given at the district level since different recipe is prepared in different places.

This will be applicable for all the cases of spot feeding of the beneficiaries. All take home ration cases will continue to be provided with cereal and pulses only, unless replaced by Ready to Eat food supplement fortified with micronutrients and vitamins.

Replacement of wheat with rice under SNP is being seriously followed up, with the Central Government and instructions regarding this will be communicated in due course.
